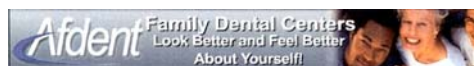

Directions:

From the North: Interstate 80/90 to Exit 77 (Notre Dame Exit), U.S. #933 south beyond downtown South Bend to Ewing St., turn right (west), proceed on Ewing for approximately 1 mile to Rum Village Park (south side of road).

From the South: U.S. #31 north to U.S. #31 business (S. Michigan Street). Continue north on S. Michigan Street toward downtown South Bend to Ewing St., turn left (west), proceed on Ewing for approximately 1 mile to Rum Village Park (south side of road).

All parking is along Ewing and Gertrude. No vehicles will be allowed in the park!

Notes:

GILLETTE GENERATORS

(1) Medals will be awarded for top 3 Indiana riders. Medals for Cat 4 & 5 will be awarded in the Cat 4/5 race and medals for Cat. 3 will be awarded in the Cat 3/4 race. Out-of-state residents are eligible for cash prizes.

(2) Prize money will be based on the number of participants up to \$500 to the top 7.

- This is a USAC sanctioned event, permit pending. All USAC rules apply.
- Standard USAC Release, along with license and I.D. will be required for **all** races.
- Race Director reserves the right to combine categories & alter cash awards based upon participation.
- **Must have annual usacycling license to qualify for state championship medals.**
- Registration will close 30 minutes prior to each event.
- Wheel pit and free lap will be in effect.
- Races will be held rain or shine.
